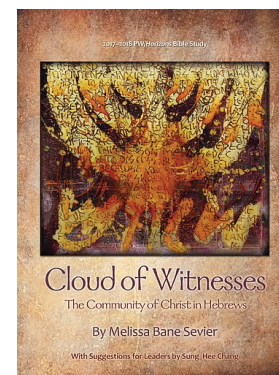


DEACON CORNER
